What is HRÖ?

The Hindu Religion Organization of Austria is a state-registered confessional community, an official representative for all activities related to Hinduism (Sanatana Dharma) in Austria.

Is Hinduism a recognized religion in Austria and what are the benefits of being recognized?

No, Hinduism is not a recognized religion in Austria. Legally recognized religious communities have extensive rights in various areas , such as the right to hold religious instruction in public schools or private schools with public rights, preferential treatment under tax law etc.

What is the Status of HRÖ currently?

Though HRÖ was formed in 1998, as of today it doesn't even have a functional website. Because of covid or other reasons, as the elections were not conducted on-time, the existing committee was dissolved by the ministry and a curator was appointed to conduct the elections. The elections will take place on 20.08.2023.

Who are we and what we are upto?

We are professionals from different fields having decades of experience in managing big tasks in our respective organizations. When the ex-president and ex-vice president of HRÖ made a wide appeal for the next generation to come forward and manage the administration of the HRÖ, we responded to the appeal and with a deep sense of duty and responsibility, we would like to take things into our hand to re-build the organization.



What will we do if we are elected?

- 1) We will work selflessly for the organization and not for any personal goals.
- 2) We shall immediately develop and launch a website and represent HRÖ in social media even if we have to fund it on our own.
- 3) A permanent E-Mail address will be made available.
- 4) We will update the details of existing members and proactively enroll new members.
- 5) We will establish self-policing procedures to ensure that all meeting minutes, decisions and actions taken by the organization and individual committee members are well documented and properly transferred to the next committee. Disciplinary action will follow if this is violated by any member.
- 6) We will conduct General Assembly once per year, without fail.
- 7) Some changes to the constitution are urgently necessary. After thorough review and due consultations, amendment proposals will be introduced in the next General Assembly for approval.
- 8) It will be made a law, that no individual can take any executive position in the HRÖ for more than 2 terms.

- 9) As envisioned in the constitution, we will immediately establish a „Sanatana Dharma Council“ and will request the Shankaracharya of Jyotirmath, Swami Avimuktешwaranand Saraswati to head the council.
- 10) As envisioned in the constitution, we will immediately establish an „Assembly of congregations“ that contains 2-3 committee members from all the recognized Hindu congregations in Austria (eg: Hindu Mandir, Sanatan Dharam temple, Sri Head Radha Govinda Gaudiya Math, Shiv Mandir etc).
- 11) We will explore all sources of funding and make the yearly HRÖ budget accordingly.
- 12) We will openly share the complete list of all incoming and outgoing payments info with all members of HRÖ on a yearly basis.
- 13) We will explore all options and aggressively try to achieve the legal recognition to Hindu religion in Austria.
- 14) We will conduct religious classes to kids and adults.
- 15) With inputs from the „Sanatana Dharma Council“ and the subject experts from India, we will prepare religious text books for Children. We will release one text book per year.
